





#### **Media Overview:**

- <u>1t.org</u> is an international community <u>launched</u> by the World Economic Forum at the 2020
  Annual Meeting in Davos, Switzerland. It supports the conservation, restoration and growth of
  one trillion trees by 2030.
- Like other Forum initiatives it promotes public private cooperation to tackle global challenges.
- The launch <u>press conference</u> saw international support from the public and private sector including the President of Colombia, the CEO of Salesforce; and civil society leaders Jane Goodall, Hindou Ibrahim and Sadhguru.
- It aims to connect, empower and mobilize a global community of millions to act at an unprecedented scale and speed to meet our climate challenges ahead.

## The Launch of 1t.org US – 27 August – First Regional Chapter

- The US Chapter will be led by the World Economic Forum and American Forests the nation's first forest conservation organization founded in 1875.
- It is an independent platform, bringing together companies, non-profits, governments, ecopreneurs, academia, grassroots organizations, and individuals. It's mission: to bring about real, concrete change on a local, national and global level contributing to the trillion trees 2030 goal.

## Pledges announced at launch

- 26 pledges from the public and private sector total 855 million trees to be conserved, restored
  or grown, demonstrating real commitments to the global trillion trees goal.
- Pledges will relate to planting trees or preventing the loss of trees. They also can relate to supporting activities, such as technology tools, market innovation, nursery expansion and workforce development.
- Anyone can pledge and join the 1t.org community for the opportunity to learn, collaborate, innovate and participate in action-oriented, multi-stakeholder dialogues.

# Why Trees?

- Healthy and resilient forests are a critical nature-based solution. They help restore biodiversity
  loss and combat climate change while providing economic opportunities. Research has
  shown that sustainable management of forests will create \$230 billion in business
  opportunities and 16 million jobs worldwide by 2030.
- Healthy forests provide services that support stronger and more resilient communities.
   Forests are a vital ecosystem that societies and economies cannot prosper without.
