The Inaugural 1t.org US Summit

In June 2022, we brought our diverse, multi-stakeholder community together for a dynamic, in-person first-ever 1t.org US Summit that left us inspired and energized.

More than 140 attendees joined the Summit in Washington, DC. Corporate and nonprofit leaders presented their vision for scaling public and private-sector ambition, federal and state government officials share their commitments to nature-based solutions, and community representatives discussed reforestation challenges.

The 2023 1t.org US Summit will be bigger and bolder, with more opportunities for the community to contribute their ideas, challenges and solutions.
